**Deadline: Friday, September 12, 2014**

The National Gallery is seeking proposals from Jamaican artists, artists' collectives, and/or curators, whether living locally or abroad, for its 2014 Jamaica Biennial, National Gallery West Special Project. National Gallery West is the NGJ's new satellite space opening in June 2014 at the old Montego Bay Civic Centre on Sam Sharpe Square. The exhibition will run from November 23, 2014 - March 19, 2015

## PROPOSAL GUIDELINES

Applicants must submit a proposal to [info@natgalia.org.im](mailto:info@natgalia.org.im) with the following:

- A cover letter (including contact name, email address, telephone number and mailing address);
- A one page project proposal describing the project, special requirements and listing the artist(s) involved;
- A current resume of each of the key contributors (maximum 2 pages each);
- Visual support material with up to 15 images or 10 minutes of video/audio material, including project diagrams/mock ups and previous work of artists involved;
- List of support material, detailing title, year, dimensions, medium and any other pertinent information;
- A project budget.

## EXHIBITION SPACE

The exhibition will be held at the new National Gallery West in the Montego Bay Cultural Centre. The exhibition space is over 130 m<sup>2</sup> with a high domed ceiling and windows on three sides. Temporary walls are available to mount work. The mounting of fixtures and fittings on buildings permanent walls is limited by its heritage status.
